RideKC Veterans Pass

Any Veteran can ride KC metro buses for FREE with the RideKC Veterans Pass. To receive a pass, Veterans must visit the Outreach Center and show a VA ID, Military ID, or a DD214 along with a picture ID.



Food and Hygiene Items

VCP provides pantry boxes, snack bags, and hygiene items to Veterans in need of assistance.

Emergency Assistance Funds

VCP provides emergency financial assistance and case management to Veterans, prioritizing those at risk for homelessness. Please note that all financial assistance is sent directly to a mortgage company, landlord, or creditor once approved. VCP can only support one emergency financial request per household. Veterans must apply online at www.vcp.org.

Veterans may call or walk-in to make an appointment with a VCP case manager. VCP provides personalized assistance with the following:
